Dr Richard Rhodes: Summary Curriculum Vitae

Dr Richard Rhodes (BA MSc PhD MCSFS) is a senior forensic consultant at J P French Associates where he has worked on over a thousand forensic cases¹ in the areas of speaker comparison, transcription and disputed utterance analysis, as well as other miscellaneous cases relating to the analysis of speech and audio recordings. Dr Rhodes has worked at J P French Associates since September 2012. This work is mostly based in the UK, but he has also worked on cases from across Ireland, Australia, Canada, and the Unites States. He works for both prosecution and defence in criminal cases, and provides evidence as an expert witness in court. He has given evidence in a range of trials including large-scale murder, terrorism and organised-crime cases at Courts across the UK including the Old Bailey, as well as in other courts including the Australian Supreme Court.

Dr Rhodes has carried out research into the effects of aging and assessing the strength of non-contemporaneous evidence, and on cognitive biases in the context of forensic speech science. He gives lectures and seminars on the MSc in Forensic Speech Science and supervises postgraduate (MSc and PhD-level) research at the University of York. He has also delivered training on forensic phonetics at the International Summer School in Forensic Linguistic Analysis at Aston University.

Dr Rhodes is a member of several relevant organisations (see below) and is the Chair of the International Association for Forensic Phonetics and Acoustics (IAFPA), having previously been treasurer and membership secretary for 9 years (both executive committee positions). In that role, he was part of the group which re-developed the IAFPA Code of Practice for experts; he is also currently co-writing a chapter on Practitioner Standards for the Oxford Handbook of Forensic Phonetics.
